Sign Tracking The first thing to learn about tracking is knowing where to look for animals Much of this is done by what is called "sign tracking"
Signs are anything besides a track proper that is an indication of an animal (eg trails, scat etc) About 1/2 of tracking is sign tracking the other 1/2 is working with actual tracks...
