Caesar's obsession with his dignitas does not preclude the possibility of a political compromise - as is witnessed by his many peace offers As the evidence clearly displays, it was only after all his attempts to negotiate a peaceful compromise with Pompey failed that Caesar finally resorted to fighting a civil war in defence of his dignitas
